

Rutabaga Paddlesports' Announces Adventurer of the Year Nominee Jon Turk to Speak at Canoecopia

Arctic Explorer Jon Turk is set to enlighten his audience during Rutabaga's 2013 Canoecopia event in Madison Wisconsin.

His expertise in trip planning has made possible some amazing adventures, such as traveling from Northern Japan to Alaska via kayak and trimaran.
